This presentation highlights the importance of thorough lower-end preparation, attention to detail, and precision in every step to maximize performance, reliability, and engine durability. 1:00 - 2:30 PM	CHRIS ALLMOND, GSC POWER DIVISION ➤ What Really Limits Engine RPM? Engineering at the Redline Chris will explore the engineering challenge of maximizing engine power at high RPM by examining the relationships between airflow, displacement, speed, and horsepower. Using a first-principles approach, it traces the entire chain of requirements, from airflow and valvetrain dynamics to bottom-end durability, lubrication, fuel delivery, ignition, combustion, and structural integrity. Key topics include redline definition, mean piston speed, valve motion and natural frequency, and the influence of air dynamics on valve events. Chris will also cover the support systems required for reliable high-speed operation, including oil control, fuel systems, and thermal management. Ultimately, the presentation provides a systems-level framework for understanding and designing high-performance, high-RPM engines.

3:00 - 4:30 PM	LAKE SPEED JR, SPEEDIAGNOSTIX ➤ The Dynamometer For Engine Health – Used Oil Analysis Just as a dyno provides data to optimize engine performance, used oil analysis measures wear metals, fuel dilution, viscosity, and contamination to assess engine condition. This presentation explains how oil analysis can be used to optimize maintenance practices, select the right lubricants and filters, and determine appropriate service intervals. Attendees will learn how data-driven oil analysis helps maximize engine reliability, durability, and operating efficiency.
